We safely played through Covid last season and are looking forward to another fun & safe golf season. We will continue to comply with best practices to minimize the spread of Covid-19, members will be updated via email of any requirements, procedures, etc. We are continuing credit card only payment of green fees.

1. Membership cards are not transferable and must be presented when registering and paying greens fees before starting to play. **No cash payment of green fees, please pay green fees with a Visa or Mastercard.**
2. The putting green is considered part of the golf course. (Greens fees are charged.) Absolutely no putting on practice green when “CLOSED” sign is displayed.
3. Each player must have a set of clubs and appropriate carry bag or club rack. Rental bags are available in the clubhouse.
4. No one will be permitted to play in bathing attire.
5. Male golfers must wear sleeved shirts.
6. It is strongly recommended that all golfers wear golf shoes – soft spikes or dimpled bottoms. Metal spikes, sandals, dress shoes, etc., are not permitted. Use caution when walking up and down sloped areas.
7. Guests must sign in with a member and the member must accompany their guest(s).
8. Resident members will be permitted up to three guests per round. Non Resident members will be permitted up to two guests per round.
9. Children under the age of eight (8) will not be permitted on the course. Children ages 8-12 must be accompanied by a golf playing adult (18 or older) who shall assume responsibility for child and adherence to all rules, regulations and safety notices or a teacher approved by the Recreation Department.
10. Non-resident members must be 13 years of age or older.
11. **NON-RESIDENT-LIMITED CATEGORY:** Play is permitted Tuesday through Friday between 10:00 A.M. and 2:00 P.M. only. Tee off time for second round must begin before 2:00 P.M.
12. The Recreation Department may close the course and suspend play when in its opinion further play would result in damage to the course or danger to the golfers.
13. The Recreation Department reserves the right to suspend the golf privileges of any member or guest for failure to comply with the rules or regulations.
14. The Recreation Department may add, delete or change any of these regulations, playing rules, dues or greens fees, should it be deemed necessary.
15. Golfers must not tee off until players in front of them have left the green.
16. All play is continuous. Players **MUST** let following players play through when you are delaying them. Slow players who do not comply and hold up other players will be asked to leave the course. Repeated offenses may result in loss of membership privileges (with no refunds).

17. Players are permitted to play one ball. Practice putting is only permitted on practice green.
18. A foursome is the maximum number of golfers permitted to play together. Absolutely no groups of five or more, under any circumstances. Management reserves the right to group players when the course is crowded.
19. **LOCAL RULE:** Maximum number of strokes per hole is seven (7). Player must pick up and move to next tee.
20. **LOCAL RULE:** Lost ball or ball out of bounds - drop another ball in fairway near the point where lost or out of bounds. Penalty one stroke.
21. **LOCAL RULE:** Player not on green after taking three strokes should pick up ball, place at edge of green and putt out. Penalty one stroke.
22. Golfers are requested to repair ball marks on the greens, to replace divots on tees and fairways, to smooth over footprints or club marks in the sand traps and to otherwise help maintain the course in good playing condition.
23. **Lightning may occur at golf course. The Par 3 does not have any lightning warning systems or lightning shelters. Accordingly – golf is at your own risk.**
24. All golfers must read the USGA lightning poster that is posted at the Par 3.
25. Members are responsible for their guests. Members must inform guests of all rules, regulations and safety notices. A copy of course rules has been mailed to all members or is included in your online registration receipt and copies for guests are available at the Par 3 office.
26. Flagstick must not be dropped on the greens or held in such a fashion as to not cause damage to the greens.
27. All golfers are requested to observe the above rules and to practice the general rules of golf courtesy.
28. Hours of operation: Course opens every day except Mondays at 8am, 12 noon on Mondays. Last tee-time is 90 minutes prior to sunset.
29. No coolers allowed on course, no alcoholic beverages allowed.
