

Par 3 Golf Course Covid-19 related Policies & Guidelines (Please read Golf Rules for additional rules.) The Millburn Recreation Department's #1 priority is to provide a safe and enjoyable golf experience for our members and Golf Course Staff. Policies & guidelines are in place for everyone's protection and to limit the spread of COVID-19. 3/15/21

Who can play:

The Millburn Par 3 is open to 2021 Millburn Recreation Golf members and their guests. If you are not registered for the 2021 Golf season, go to www.bit.ly/millburnrecreg and you can register online with Community Pass. Returning members, bring your golf ID Badge. New members, please bring your new Golf ID Badge or a copy of your email receipt if you have not yet been mailed your ID Badge. Memberships are available to Millburn residents, age 8 and older and to a limited # of non-residents. Members must provide contact information for their guests' when paying greens fees at the course.

If you or family members have Covid-19 or have displayed any symptoms or have been a close contact of someone with Covid-19 within the last 14 days, do not use the Golf Course. Close contacts are individuals who were within 6 feet of a confirmed COVID-19 case for a prolonged period of time (approximately 10 minutes or more) or had direct contact with the infectious secretions of a COVID-19 case (e.g., were coughed on).

How to pay greens fee or pull cart fee:

Pay by credit card only, (Master Card or Visa – no cash accepted). Your ID badge will be scanned (through a glass window) and you will swipe your credit card to pay the greens fee outside of the clubhouse window. Note: no membership registrations will be taken at clubhouse, online only – thank you. If a member is bringing a guest, the member must pay for the guest via credit card. Resident green fees are \$4 weekdays & \$6 weekends. Non-resident fees are \$6 & \$9 respectively. Guest fees are \$10 weekdays & \$13 on weekends. **Note:** only one group (maximum of 4 golfers) may be under the clubhouse roof in order to pay fees. Others must wait in line outside the clubhouse gate until the group ahead of them have vacated the clubhouse area. On Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays there will be a separate line for those with Tee Times.

Tee Times can be made for play on Friday, Saturday and Sunday by calling the clubhouse at (973) 379-4156 beginning on Tuesday of each week. Note: for tee times on either April 2, 3 or 4 you may call beginning on April 1. See Tee Time Procedures for Members document.

Social Distancing & Face coverings:

Golfers and staff, from the time they arrive in the parking lot till the time they return to their cars, **must practice social distancing (a minimum of 6')** and are required to wear face coverings if social distancing measures are difficult to maintain. Furthermore, anytime you are under the clubhouse roof (to pay greens fees), you must wear a face covering. It is recommended that you also wear a face covering while playing and you must maintain social distancing especially at the tee boxes and greens.

Cleaning, Hand Sanitizer, Restrooms & other guidelines:

Hand Sanitizer will be provided at Clubhouse sign in window. Golfers should bring their own hand sanitizer for use on the course. Restrooms are available if requested. Avoid touching any fencing, gates, railings, etc. Course staff will frequently clean/disinfect their work stations, area outside clubhouse window, the restrooms and rented pull carts. No touching of flagstick, leave them in (special cups have been installed to easily retrieve your ball only). The deck area is currently off limits. Limited use of the putting green will be available for individuals who have paid greens fees and are waiting to tee off. Players must handle and use their own clubs & equipment only; no sharing of clubs or balls. No rental clubs available. Only one group at a time at any tee box. All rakes, ball washers and watercoolers have been removed from the course. Players should refrain from congregating and handshaking at conclusion of round. Please participate in course etiquette by fixing all ball marks on greens, replacing all divots with turf and smoothing bunker sand with your club or shoes.

In order to keep our course open, you must adhere to policies & guidelines. Thank you for your cooperation and together we can adapt, enjoy golf and look forward to a better and healthier time.
